



Jury Process

The gallery is currently accepting applications in all media; we would *especially* like to increase the number of 3-D artists and jewelers in our membership. We review applications and vote on new members at our monthly membership meeting, which is the second Tuesday of each month. When we have openings, we jury – please check with the gallery to see if applications are being accepted when you plan to apply. The schedule for our next jury session is below.

To apply for membership, fill out the Membership Application and attach a copy of your resume or biography and/or artists' statement. Please mail or email these to the gallery by the Application Deadline to ensure you will be included in the Juried Session. Next, bring your work samples (at least five; more for jewelers) to the gallery the weekend **before** our jury session. We will review your portfolio **and** any publicity or marketing materials that you may have. All work must be identified with name, title, medium and price.

Keep in mind that we are looking at your artwork as well as your application materials while considering you for membership, so it is in your best interest to bring high quality work that is ready for exhibition. Bring work *exactly* as you would display it in the gallery – the way that your artwork is framed (or otherwise presented) is also evaluated. You **must** pick up your work from the gallery on the second Wednesday of the month between noon and 8pm – the gallery cannot store artwork. You will be notified by mail of the results.

FEBRUARY

Application deadline: February 8 at 6pm
Drop off work: Feb 7 (noon to 8 pm) or Feb 8 (10 am – 6 pm)
Jury Session: February 10
Pick up work: February 11 (noon to 8 pm)

MAY

Application deadline: May 5 at 6pm
Drop off work: May 9 (noon to 8 pm) or May 10 (10 am – 6 pm)
Jury Session: May 12
Pick up work: May 13 (noon to 8 pm)

Note: Artwork must be picked up on the PICK UP DAY. If you are not able to pick up your artwork during business hours, please make other arrangements.
