## **Benefits of Membership**

- Participation in the running of a gallery and in the vision of a grassroots arts organization
- Information about professional development and artist opportunities
- The gallery receives a 30% commission on all members' work sold. Artists are paid by check the month following the sale

## **Membership Requirements**

- Sign a one-year contract, agreeing to full participation
- Work 2-3 4-hour shifts in the gallery, monthly
- Attend monthly membership meetings, participate in gallery operations, and rotate duties for events such as setting up and staffing openings
- Take on a gallery job and/or community role
- Provide new work for every exhibit in which you are included
- Pay monthly dues by the 1st of each month

Monthly dues are as follows:

- \$75 per month for exhibiting in 50% of the shows
- \$100 per month for exhibiting in 75% of the shows
- \$125 per month for exhibiting in 100% of the shows

## **Application Process**

The gallery accepts applications in all media, though we would especially like to encourage Southeast Seattle, BIPOC, and 3-D artists to apply for membership. We review applications and vote on new members at our monthly membership meeting on the second Tuesday of each month. Applications received by the 20<sup>th</sup> of the month will be reviewed at the following meeting.

To apply for membership, fill out the online Membership Application. You'll be asked to submit your art cv/resume, an artist statement, and 5-10 images of your artwork. The Membership Committee will reach out to you with information about the next steps.
